Church Finances By Don Coleman

With worship services commencing in October, our financial situation is starting to improve. Our revenues for October were \$8,106.63, including \$6,871 in givings. Our expenses for the same period were \$6,225.54. This is the first time since February that our income has exceeded expenses. We are very fortunate to be in a comfortable financial situation at this time.



Our Mission and Service givings are currently at

\$7,483 which is about 62% of our target of \$12,000. We have about 6 weeks left to reach this target. Mission and Service is the outreach arm of the United Church of Canada, providing support for many programs throughout Canada and around the world.

We are also looking for support for our Christmas Food Hamper program. This year because of the pandemic restrictions, we will be giving out gift cards from the local Foodland store instead of food hampers.

We would like to thank everyone for their continued support over the last several difficult months.
